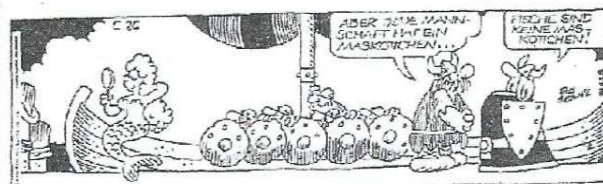
1. My father was the keeper of the Eddy stone Light, he slept with a mer-maid one fine night.
